Leader sings and audience repeats:

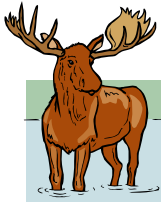
There was a great big moose

Boom-dee-ah-dah, boom-dee-ah-dah.

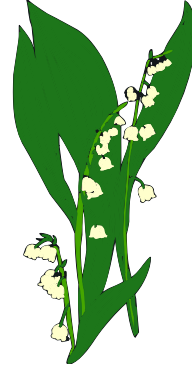
I love the mountains;
